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## **Policy Reminders**

Quarantine:

The length of the quarantine period from an exposure is determined by local activity rate of infection. Union County is currently HIGH.

Therefore quarantines are currently 14 days long.

You cannot test out of an exposure quarantine.

Travel:

Please remember that your children are unvaccinated and travel outside of NJ, NY and PA will require your child to quarantine upon return.
